Compostable Transparent Bags - You can use these bags if certified under ASTM D 6400 or CAN/BNQ 0017-088 and have both the following logos visible on the bags:



Leaves & Grass Clippings - Although we prefer transparent green bags, orange, clear, and paper bags can be used for leaves.

Tips & Tricks

Diapers and Pet Waste - They are preferred in the clear Garbages bag, but may go in the Organics bag on weeks Garbage is not collected.

Ropes, Cables, Wire - To prevent mechanical sorting equipment from becoming entangled and breaking, always place these items in the Garbage.

* Soft plastics and flexible packaging can be brought to redemption centers for recycling. We accept these items in our clear bag as a last resort.

Never put these items in your regular household waste; bring them to our Mobile Eco-Depot, Solid Waste Facility, or visit our website for other disposal details.
